Car from M50: Exit at junction 13, follow the signs for Dundrum Town Centre/ Green car park.

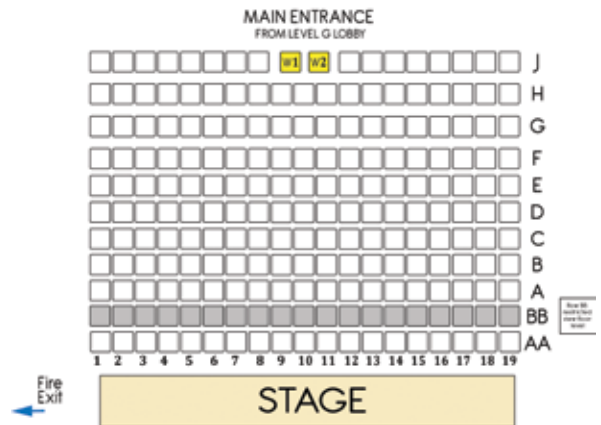
